Rules for Asking Questions

1. Proposers of questions must print their question on the forms provided by the Chamber and indicate their first & last name. Only hand-written and signed questions on official Chamber forms will be allowed. **PLEASE PRINT LEGIBLY. KEEP YOUR QUESTIONS BRIEF & TO THE POINT. ONLY ONE QUESTION PER FORM.**
2. Question forms will be available at the designated table by the Chamber. Each question form must be returned to and numbered by the Chamber representative at the question form table. Since the whole evening is timed, it is important to submit your question as soon as possible. All numbered questions will be given to the moderator, regardless if time allows for the questions or not.
3. The proposers of the questions are to be prepared to stand during the reading of the question. If a proposer is *not* prepared to stand during the reading of the question, the candidate has the option of responding or not. If circumstances prevent the proposer from standing, the moderator will use his or her discretion.
4. Each candidate will be given a 20 second time remaining warning bell during their opening/closing remarks & responses. If the candidate exceeds the allowed time, the moderator will ask the candidate to cease speaking.
5. Questions will be screened for duplication and integrity. Questions negatively targeting personal character will not be tolerated. The moderator will have the final say in the event of discrepancy.
